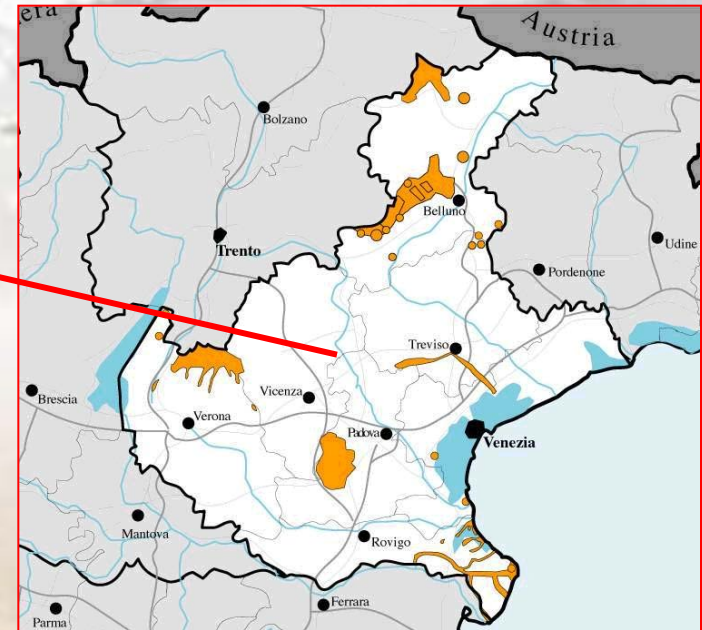
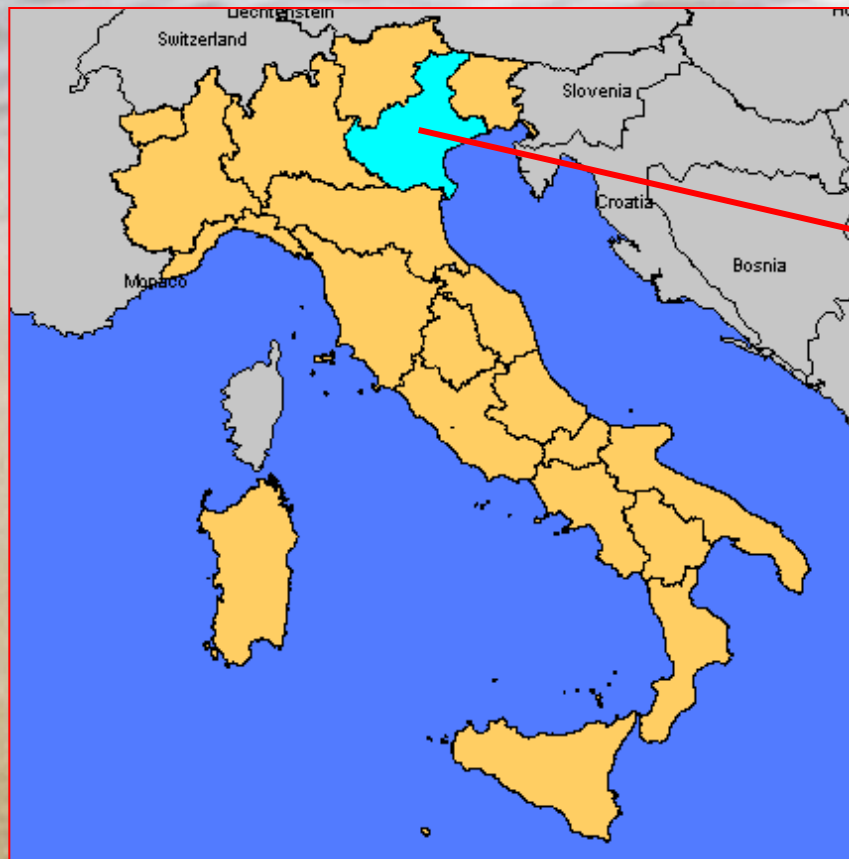

Veneto Region and PRPS

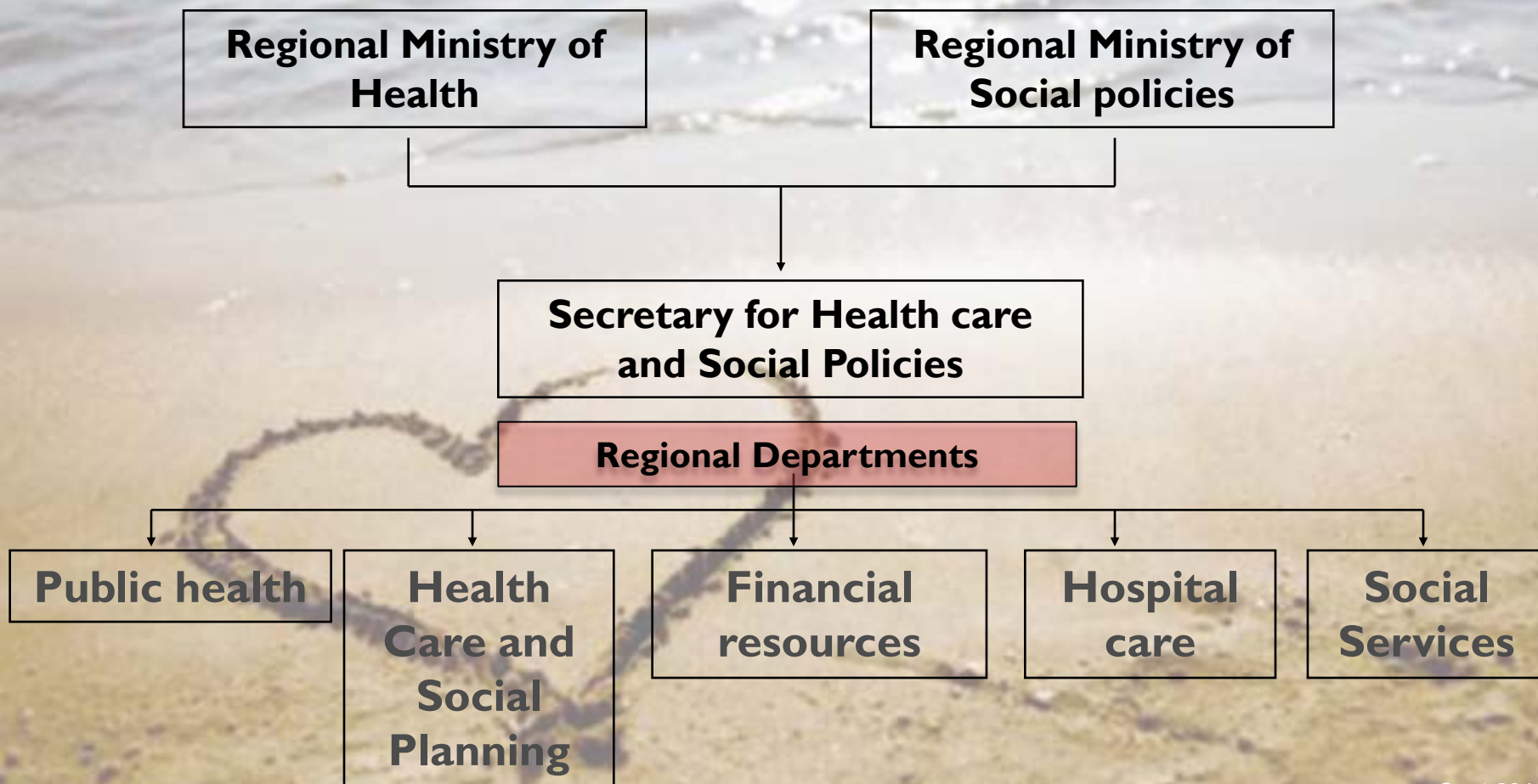
Veneto Region is an autonomous territorial organisation with legislative and executives powers. The Veneto Regional Government provides health and social services to the resident population through 21 Local Health Authorities and 2 Hospital Trusts.

The European and international dimensions are seen as paramount for the development of the regional health system. For this reason Veneto Region is member of several EU networks and institutions.

The **Regional Programme for Health Promotion** (in Italian: PRPS) is an **instrumental office of Veneto Region** and part of the Regional Public Health System.

Regional Partnership

The partners and their role/practical tasks :

- Veneto Region, **Health and Social Affairs Secretariat** (legal representative)
- Veneto Region, **International Health and Social Affairs Office** (acting on the project strategic level)
- Veneto Region, **Brussels Office** (in charge of project secretariat & link with Main Partner and PHEA)
- Veneto Region, **Regional Programme for Health Promotion** (in charge of project scientific implementation and management)
- **Local Healthcare Authorities' offices for health education and health promotion** (in charge of pilot project implementation)
- **Local Healthcare Authorities' offices for food security and nutrition** (in charge of pilot project implementation)

The Collaborating Partners' Network

Creation of a regional network of Collaborating Partners including “key observers” working at strategic level within the Region in different sectors related to health.

- Internal decree sent by the Secretary General for Health Care and Social Affairs of Veneto Region to the Directors General of the LHA, establishing the regional network (**top-down**).
- Formal commitment from the Director General of each involved LHA to the heads of local services.

The PRPS has kept constantly in touch with this network (working in close collaboration on the deliverables) and sending frequent update (via e-mail) about all the activities of the project.

Team work to work on the Deliverables and select pilot projects promoting healthy lifestyles in the school setting and in families (**bottom-up**).

PROCEDURE PROTOCOL (*action-research*)

Preparatory meeting to the Evaluation Seminar involving all the collaborating partners

- Sept 2009: working document for the evaluation of the CPs participation in the project and pilots projects implementation presented in Verona and then shown at the Swedish partner meeting (*Process evaluation questionnaire*)
- May 2010: *Final evaluation questionnaire* CPs reported back the results of the pilot projects and made an assessment of their impact in the schools
